



The Sanctuary Lamp Week of January 5, 2020 Is in Memory of Louis and Anna D'Amato



Sometimes called Twelfth Night (12 days after Christmas), Epiphany is derived from the Greek word meaning "manifestation." We commemorate the occasion on which God, through Christ, was made manifest to the whole world, represented by the Magi. Epiphany was first used in the Christian sense by St. Paul referring to both the first and final coming of Christ in his letter to Timothy "He saved us...now made manifest through the appearance of our savior Christ Jesus, who brought life and immortality to light through the gospel...." and in his letter to Titus "For the grace of God has appeared saving us all...as we await the blessed hope, the appearance of the great God and our savior Jesus Christ."

EPIPHANY OF THE LORD



WHO WERE THE MAGI?

We sing songs, give gifts, and move three mysterious men into our manger scenes. There's a rich heritage in the Catholic Church of celebrating the magi, but their origins are steeped in mystery. The original Greek calls these men magoi. The word

is translated elsewhere in Scripture to mean "magician," but a similar word was used in ancient history to describe an entirely different set of people altogether. In what is now modern-day Iran, the ruling empire had a wealthy priestly caste known as the Magi. At the time of Christ, the Magi formed one of the ruling councils of the Parthian Empire. These priests interpreted dreams and read the stars to anticipate major events that could affect the fortunes of the empire.

We're not exactly sure where the magi of the Gospels traveled from. Matthew simply says "the east." History tells us that the ancient regions of Persia, Assyria, and Babylon all had a magi priesthood at the time of Christ. Whichever region they hailed from, they likely traveled over one thousand miles over the course of several months to arrive at the Holy Family. There is no concrete evidence these men were themselves kings, though they did bear gifts at the prompting of their astronomical calculations.

THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD In cultures around the world, light and darkness are chief symbols of good and evil, order



and chaos, clarity and confusion, hope and despair. God has given us the created world as a gift. His first work, as we see in Genesis 1, is to create light. It is in the light that the rest of creation comes to be. A gathering darkness emerges in Genesis 3. Adam and Eve hide, shrouding themselves from the sun's rays and the gaze of God. While God offers a promise of salvation and establishes a covenant with His people, the sense of fog and dim understanding still remain. The Hebrew people repeatedly betray the promises they made to God, and all around them the nations actively worship idols.

The promise of God is not in vain, however. In John 1, we see a depiction of Christ as primordial goodness, order, clarity, and hope. "The true light, which enlightens everyone was coming into the world ... this life was the light of the human race" (John 1: 9, 4). Think of the last sunrise you witnessed. As you watched the lavender brighten to rose edged with gold, did your heart swell? Did you recall the goodness of the world? Such is the role of Christ in the soul. Such is his coming Incarnate in our world.


