Editor's Note: The following proclamation, delivered during the Civil War, may have opening paragraphs that seem inappropriate for us, having been living through the Covid-19 this year. However, the overall message applies. Let us remember, and be thankful for the blessings we do receive daily, trials not withstanding.



PRESIDENT ABRAHAM LINCOLN'S THANKSGIVING DAY PROCLAMATION October 3, 1863

"The year that is drawing toward its close has been filled with the blessings of fruitful fields and healthful skies. To these bounties, which are so constantly enjoyed that we are prone to forget the source from which they come, others have been added, which are of so extraordinary a nature that they cannot fail to penetrate and even soften the heart which is habitually insensible to the everwatchful providence of Almighty God.

"No human counsel hath devised, nor hath any mortal hand worked out these great things. They are the gracious gifts of the Most High God, who while dealing with us in anger for our sins, hath nevertheless remembered mercy.

"It has seemed to me fit and proper that they should solemnly, reverently, and gratefully acknowledged as with one heart and one voice by the whole American people. I do, therefore, invite my fellow-citizens in every part of the United States, and also those who are at sea and those who are sojourning in foreign lands, to set apart and observe the last Thursday of November next as a Day of Thanksgiving and Praise to our beneficent Father who dwelleth in the heavens. And I recommend to them that, while offering up the ascriptions justly due to Him for such singular deliverances and blessings, they do also, with humble penitence for national perverseness and disobedience, ...fervently implore the interposition of the Almighty hand to heal the wounds of the nation, and to restore it, as soon as may be consistent with the Divine purposes, to the full enjoyment of peace, harmony, tranquility and union.

"In testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the United Stated States to be affixed. Done at the city of Washington, this third day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, and of the Independence of the United States the eighty-eighth."

A FAMILY PERSPECTIVE

As we gather to give thanks this week, we must also ask how well we share with "the least." Happiness is secured not by having, but by sharing.

THE DAILY EXAMEN of ST. IGNATIUS LOYOLA

A great way to pray is to look for God's presence in your life. St. Ignatius Loyola proposed the **Daily Examen**, a technique of prayerful reflection on the events of the day to detect God's presence and to discern His direction for us.

- 1. **Become aware of God's presence**. Look back on the events of the day. Ask God to bring clarity and understanding.
- 2. **Review the day with gratitude**. Walk through your day and note its joys and delights. Focus on the day's gifts. God is in the details.
- 3. **Pay attention to your emotions**. Reflect on the feelings you experienced during the day. What is God saying trough these feelings?
- **4.** Choose one feature of the day and pray from it. Ask the Holy Spirit to direct you to something during the day that God thinks is particularly important.
- 5. Look toward tomorrow. Ask God to give you Light for tomorrow's challenges. Seek God's guidance. Ask Him for help and understanding. Pray for Hope. Talk to Jesus like a friend. End the Daily Examen with a conversation with Jesus. Ask forgiveness for your sins. Ask for His Protection and help. Ask for His wisdom. Your life is a gift and it is adorned with gifts from God.

End the Daily Examen with the Our Father.
