

#### A GOSPEL REFLECTION


"Spiraling out of control" is a phrase that can easily describe the current display of human existence. In addition to the violence, unrest, uneasiness and turmoil that are common elements of our daily news, other essential pieces are missing. Many lack an objective center around which to order and structure their lives or a clear set of definable goals or mores to act as guideposts. "Feelings" have become a "new god" and traditional structures and ideals have been set aside. It is almost as if history only shows that we got the whole thing wrong and many are determined finally to set things right. Errors and wrongs are certainly a part of our past, but all was not wrong. We do not rewrite the history of our lives, but we must learn from mistakes that were made and preserve the wisdom that comes from our successes. Learning is an essential part of being human.

From whom do we learn?

God is the Master Teacher from whom all of humanity learns. It is through this relationship that we are fashioned into the people we are intended to be and can be. It is only in God that we are able to find our best selves.

Many today think that religion, as well as history in general, has gotten all this wrong. Our faith tells us differently. We are reminded today that we are meant to remain in Christ as Christ remains in us. We are also reminded that **Jesus**, the Incarnate God. is the vine upon which we grow, the branches that flow from the source of God's life.

It is not easy to set our own desires and wants aside and allow God to step in and direct and guide our growth. God's commandments are the very guideposts we need, yet many seek to remove them from all public view because they appear to limit self-expression and suppress what is considered by many to be "human freedom." However, they are the only way we can find freedom.

## ASSISTED SUICIDE BILL DIES IN JUDICIARY COMMITTEE

The Judiciary Committee failed to take any action on *House Bill 6425 "An Act Concerning Aid in Dying for Terminally Ill Patients,"* resulting in the death of the bill for this legislative session. This type of legislation has gone by many names such as aid-in-dying and physician-assisted suicide.

Christopher Healy, Ex. Dir. Of the CT. Catholic Public Affairs Conf. stated: "All glory goes to God. People of faith came together and their voices were heard and we are most grateful to legislators who realized we must show compassion and support for those who are in distress and isolation, rather than lead people away from hope and love.

"This victory belongs to the thousands of people from all faiths who got involved because they believe life is sacred and God-given. We have more to do and must improve palliative and hospice care, educate families on pain management and increase resources for mental health services."


