

We offer training and resources for those who might be interested. We would like to reintroduce the greeter ministry and will be looking for those who would like to serve as greeters before Masses. We will be bringing back altar servers and will be beginning training classes for new altar servers. We had begun classes right when COVID began and will start these classes anew.

The most important enhancement to our worship any of us can contribute is to be present. While COVID made worshipping together difficult, we need to recognize that it is in worshipping together that Christ becomes most present in our community. All of us have a responsibility to be part of this.
