

Sanctuary Lamp

Have you ever noticed the red light flickering next to the altar? That is the Sanctuary Lamp - a symbol that Christ is with us. Typically fueled by oil or wax, and generally in a red glass container, the lamp is kept near the tabernacle where the Blessed Sacrament is kept. It is kept alight to indicate and honor the presence of Christ and his abiding love, and a reminder to the faithful to respond with loving adoration in return. Just like Mass intentions, you can do the same with the lamp for a whole week with an announcement in the bulletin and it is \$20.


